

**FREE RABIES CLINIC – MARK YOUR  
CALENDAR FOR JANUARY 19<sup>th</sup>**

East Amwell Township will sponsor a free rabies clinic on Saturday, January 19, 2019 from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the East Amwell Township Garage located at 1070 Route 202/31 in Ringoes, (corner of Wertsville Road). Dog license payment will be accepted at that time. Tags will be mailed. Cost of license is \$17.00 for an altered dog, \$20.00 for an unaltered dog. Please bring your pet on a leash or in a carrier. Dogs and cats are required by the State of NJ to be vaccinated for rabies. However, licenses for cats are not required in East Amwell. The rabies vaccination *MUST be valid through November 1, 2019* per state (NJAC 8:23A 4.1) code. If we receive payment and your dog(s) vaccination expires before November 1<sup>st</sup>, your check will be returned to you. Also, if your dog medically cannot receive a rabies shot your veterinarian can fill out a CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION FROM RABIES VACCINATION form available from our office or at <http://state.nj.us/health/forms/vph-28>.

*v Remember-a vaccinated pet is a healthy pet! τ*  
Your dog's license expires on January 31, 2019. ALL dogs must be licensed no later than February 29, 2019 in order to avoid late fees. Beginning March 1, there is a late fee of \$25 per dog. It is your obligation and responsibility to license your dog(s). Any questions please call 908-782-8536, extension 10.

NOTE: If you are not available to go to the Rabies Clinic on January 19<sup>th</sup> other municipalities hold rabies clinics, and they are free to all NJ residents with their pets. You will receive the required proof of vaccination.
