

Call to Order:

The June 2, 2011 meeting of the East Amwell Township Recreation Committee was called to order at 7:27PM.

In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act Christine Rosikiewicz noted that this was a regular meeting. Notice of this meeting was filed in the Township Clerk's Office, sent to the Hunterdon County Democrat, the Trenton Times and the Star Ledger. The agenda was posted on the bulletin board on May 31, 2011.

Present were Angelo Lovisa (Committee Chair), Dawn Payne (Vice-Chair), Rob Mulcahy and Secretary/Member Christine Rosikiewicz. Mike Dendis and Mike Gum were absent.

Approval of Minutes: R. Mulcahy made a motion to approve the May 5, 2011 meeting minutes with two minor corrections, A. Lovisa seconded the motion. All were in favor with Dawn Payne abstaining; the May 5, 2011 meeting minutes were approved.

Announcements: A. Lovisa announced that the first Movie Night is a week from tomorrow. D. Payne will contact East Amwell School to borrow the sound system and will obtain a backup copy of the movie.

Budget: A. Lovisa reported that there are no changes to the budget since last month. He would like to request \$250 next year for a dedicated phone line for the Recreation Committee to use. This phone line will allow the committee to set up a "hot line" to cancel or reschedule an event if needed. Currently the committee is using an unused extension (extension 15). C. Rosikiewicz recorded a message and will update the message if need be; the phone does not accept messages but callers are asked to leave a message at another extension (extension 11).

Publicity for the upcoming Movie Night was briefly discussed; C. Rosikiewicz distributed fliers to the school and requested Mr. Colt do an "e-mail blast", which has taken place.

It was noted that the Volleyball program has two remaining sessions; no new equipment will be needed this year. A basketball may need to be purchased in the fall for the Winter Basketball program.

Old Business:

FOSPC: C. Rosikiewicz attended the May FOSPC Meeting; open space in the township that is available for hiking was discussed. She provided this information to D. Payne who is organizing a Recreation Committee sponsored hike in the fall.

Webpage: A. Lovisa added the Summer Movie Night information to the website.

SCSL: A. Lovisa requested SCSL coordinate with the landscaper regarding reseeding the school soccer fields; he has not heard anything back yet at this time.

AVLBL: D. Payne reported that baseball season is ending. Saturday is the closing picnic then tournaments will begin.

Math and Science Club: R. Mulcahy reported that the number of meetings may be cut back due to low turnout.

Summer Movie Nights: C. Rosikiewicz, R. Mulcahy, D. Payne and A. Lovisa will be in attendance.

Volleyball: C. Rosikiewicz shared e-mails from M. MacDuff, the volleyball program is going well. Mr. MacDuff has been sending e-mail blasts through the school to publicize the event; six to eight people have been attending each session.

New Business:

Membership: D. Payne commented that we need new members. Advertising in the VIP, township website and via e-mail blasts through the school were suggested by members.

There were no comments on any correspondence.

There was no public present.

There being no further business, a motion was made by D. Payne, seconded by R. Mulcahy and it was carried unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 8:09p.m.
