

A special meeting of the East Amwell Township Committee came to order at 7:20 PM. Present were Deputy Mayor Linda F. Lenox and Committee Members Patricia Cregar, Timothy Martin, Larry Tatsch. Mayor Peter Kneski was absent.

In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act, a copy of notice of this meeting was filed in the Clerk's Office, posted on the bulletin board, and sent to the Hunterdon County Democrat, Times of Trenton, and Star Ledger on April 5, 2010. The purpose of this meeting is to meet and interview a candidate for the 2010 Recreation Committee. The public is invited to attend. Action may or may not be taken.

Dawn Payne, a candidate for the Recreation Committee, was present. A copy of her Citizen's Advisory Form was provided to the governing body, indicating her background and interests. She has already attended Recreation Committee meetings and has helped with some events. She has children ages 7 and 5, and she is a member of the PTO. She is familiar with field use activities, and she applauded the movie night offered by the Recreation Committee. She hopes to attend the Holiday Tree Lighting event, although it falls on an inopportune night for her each year.

Mr. Tatsch attended the recent Recreation Committee meeting, and he saw Mrs. Payne at that time. He felt that she was very enthusiastic, she has helped the Committee so far, and he hoped that she would be appointed to the Committee.

Mrs. Payne commented on some of her activities, including being a three year Girl Scout leader, who may be taking on an additional troop next year. Mrs. Cregar asked if Mrs. Payne would be able to have her troop plant flowers at Clawson Park this year, and Mrs. Payne agreed.

The governing body thanked Mrs. Payne for volunteering, and the Clerk will let her know about the decision made at the regular meeting later this evening.

Motion by Mr. Martin, seconded by Mr. Tatsch, and it was carried unanimously to adjourn the meeting at 7:25 p.m.
