

A special meeting of the East Amwell Township Committee came to order at 7:15 PM. Present were Mayor Larry Tatsch, Deputy Mayor Patricia Cregar, and Committee members Peter Kneski and Tim Mathews. Committee member Linda Lenox was absent.

In compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act, a copy of notice of this meeting was filed in the Clerk's Office, posted on the bulletin board, and sent to the Hunterdon County Democrat, Times of Trenton, and Star Ledger on January 13, 2011. The purpose of this meeting is to interview a candidate for a position on a 2011 board/committee. The public is invited to attend and comment. Action may or may not be taken.

Mr. Charles Van Horn, a resident on Snyderstown Road, is interested in serving on the Board of Health.

Mr. Van Horn has resided in East Amwell for fourteen years; he is retired and currently employed as a real estate agent. He is available to attend meetings on a regular basis.

Mayor Tatsch explained the functions of the Board of Health including septic systems and well applications. Mr. Van Horn is familiar with septic systems and wells, including the required testing, through his experience as a realtor.

The Township Committee will be discussing an appointment recommendation at the regular meeting this evening, and the Clerk will notify Mr. Van Horn of the decision. The interview was adjourned at 7:25p.m.
