Oct 22

Saturday, October 22 at 10am – **Walking Tour of Ringoes** narrated by local historian Dave Harding. Start at the Clawson House at Clawson Park and see where Dr. Cornelius Larison lived, the 1734 Islee Tavern and John Ringo's Tavern. Hear about John Ringoes' Gold and see the house where The Marquis De Lafayette stayed to recover. Cost is \$10

Oct 23

Sunday, October 23 at 1pm. Take a **Historic Bus Tour of East Amwell** with local historian Jim Davidson. Travel to obscure sites around the township such as the former KKK headquarters, see where the Wyckoff murders occurred; see where gypsies would stay when traversing the area and where Walter Hill killed and buried a buffalo in the Township in the 1980's. Meet at the Municipal Building at 1pm. Cost is \$20.
