NEW BUSINESS

Pavilion: Deputy Clerk Dymek will handle pavilion rentals moving forward. Deputy Clerk Dymek will advise the Parks and Recreation Committee of any reservations. All rental monies will be deposited in to the Clawson Park fund. Chair Nelson advised that the PTO have paid for pavilion rentals through June. A discussion was had regarding whether or not all non-profits or just the school should not pay to use the pavilion. It was decided that only the school would be exempt from paying to use the pavilion (\$50+\$15 rain date fee, non-refundable).

- **A resolution stating such should be written and submitted to Clerk Giliberti for review. Member Kavchok will draft and send accordingly.**

Acting Secretary Kavchok called for a motion to have the East Amwell Township School PTO, a 501c3 organization, exempt from paying rental fees for the Clawson Park Pavilion.

- **A motion to exempt the EATS PTO from Pavilion payments was moved by Member Nardi and seconded by Chair Nelson. All in favor by voice vote.**
