



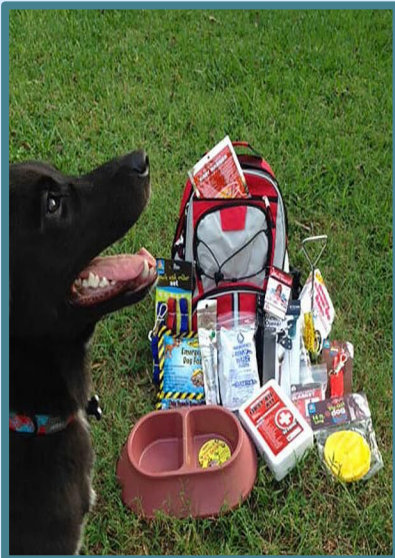
## We Are East Amwell Girl Scout Troop 80380

### Our Silver Award Project

When animals are in a home that catches fire, floods, or has another emergency we want the firefighters to be aware of the number and type of pets in the house. So, we created emergency pet rescue window clings for East Amwell residents with house pets. The second part of our project is to provide emergency rescue kits to the firefighters and first responders to address immediate pet needs until they can be taken to a vet.



# Disaster Plan for Pets

Whether it's a disaster or an emergency, planning ahead will save valuable time—and keep pets safe

## Prepare a "grab & go" bag

Keep a bag filled with at least a five-day supply of these essential pet supplies in a readily-accessible area.



## Pet kennels and bedding

- Familiar bedding can reduce pets' stress.
- A pet carrier or a kennel shields pets from noise, curious onlookers and other wandering pets and prevents pets from fleeing.

## Find a pet-friendly hotel

Keep a list of at least three pet-friendly hotels outside your immediate area in your pet's go-bag.

## Locate a shelter that accepts pets

Not all evacuation shelters accept pets. Research shelters now, keep info in your pet's go-bag.

## Reach out to friends

Who would be willing to shelter your pet in an emergency? Make arrangements ahead of time.

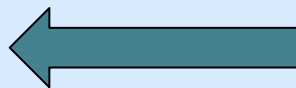
